TAPITUDE bumped lightly with TURF AND ROSES leaving the gate, took up a forward position after the start, was lightly coaxed while stalking the pacesetter towards the two path, bided time down the backstretch, picked up interest and closed in after entering the far turn, was set down in unison with POSSUM IMPOSSIBLE turning for home, spurred away from the competition, racing as a team with the aforementioned rival during the run through the furlong grounds, emerged with a clear edge by the eighth pole, then dug in to hold off a resurgent runner up to preserve the decision. LADY ON THE RUN raced within range along the outside, maintained position as best as possible under mild urging while lacking sufficient room from the three-eighths pole to the five-sixteenths pole, was given her cue approaching the quarter pole, appeared to be spinning her wheels in place as the front runners lengthened away, continued onward, found her best stride leaving the furlong grounds, then finished with good, but belated energy to garner place honors. POSSUM IMPOSSIBLE looped by rivals to grab the lead during the run around the first turn, was let out a notch midway down the backstretch to gain sufficient clearance before guided over to the rail, felt the top one's presence late on the far turn, was roused nearly simultaneously with that opponent, drew clear along with that foe from the rest of the field, began to lose contact with the winner nearing the eighth pole, continued weakening and got out finished for place honors as well. TURF AND ROSES lightly bumped at the start, underwent a three to four wide journey and rallied mildly en route for the last major award. BEAUTIFUL RISK three wide around both turns, had no kick. MOMMY'S DEAREST raced along the outside and failed to menace. JAN BETH JO had a three wide journey and was no factor. PAT'S MEOW saved ground and retreated after completing three-quarters.
