KARAKORUM JETE raced between rivals for most of the way around the turn, tipped outward an additional path after entering the stretch before commencing to rally in earnest, gained readily on the front runners, drew alongside in the vicinity of the sixteenth pole, went by and held sway, driving. FELDBERG bumped with SHAHZADI, getting carried into CIMINELLA and bumping with that opponent as well, tucked along the rail soon afterwards, lagged behind in the early going, picked up speed under encouragement nearing the quarter pole, altered course to the outside, three to four paths for optimal racing clearance approaching the eighth pole, then finished with a belated flourish to garner place honors. GREAT CLIFF brushed with PRIVATE ESCORT a jump out of the gate, chased three wide, was asked for a response, bidding for the lead coming to the quarter pole, made good progress before flattening out in the late stages. PRIVATE ESCORT bobbed slightly after brushing with GREAT CLIFF just after the start, proceeded to come outward a path or two after the contact, but was grabbed hold in time to avoid any serious contact with other rivals, was taken over to the rail down the backstretch, tracked the pacesetter from there, was urged from about midpoint on the turn, angled out for the stretch drive, but failed to gain ground appreciably. SODA KAPS coaxed while setting the pace from the two path, weakened during the final furlong. CIMINELLA stumbled after being bumped at the start, and failed to reach a contending position. OCALA JORGE raced three wide on the turn and was no threat. SHAHZADI bumped lightly with FELDBERG at the start, left the backstretch four wide and folded.
