TOE JAM FOOTBALL lunged coming out of the starting gate, sat reserved for most of the way down the backstretch, picked up interest coming to the half mile pole just as the runner up was also doing so while taking the inside route, entered the turn stacked four four, was asked for some run at the midway point, went on for another sixteenth then got set down, made no headway on the leader, yet remained within striking distance, imitated LUCK IN THE CITY by moving towards the rail in upper stretch, altered course in the vicinity of the three-sixteenths pole, began to close in readily after finishing this maneuver, poked a head down in front with an eighth to go and kicked clear. LUCK IN THE CITY the only member of the field to spend significant time along the inside, unleashed a quick rail move coming to the end of the backstretch to take over the front, edged away from the closest pursuers, lightly hand urged while at the same time the top one was being asked for a response to keep pace, had drifted to be slightly more than two wide for the start of the stretch drive, came inward in upper stretch, with the winner willingly moving over to the rail too, got collared by that foe in midstretch, continued on well to remain well clear of the others for the place. GRACE'S NEH NEH in the three path at the three-eighths pole, failed to menace. MISS SILVER BIRCH briefly three wide at the top of the turn, was guided over towards the inside after going about halfway around it, was under a drive cutting the corner into the lane, made no headway. SPEEDY LEE D raced along the outside and was outrun. SHOULD MAKE IT kept off the inside after a getaway from the gate with no apparent trouble, got displayed by the runner up at the half mile pole, tired.
