Footnotes

MAKE YOUR MOVE saved ground in mid pack racing in hand, ranged up into prominence nearing the quarter pole, scraped the paint cutting the corner into the stretch, rallied through narrow clearance down on the rail to seize command past the three-sixteenths the inner most of three noses apart at that station, edged clear under a vigorous hand ride to the wire. CHAPMAN stumbled at the start nearly to his face, bumped lightly with KENTUCKY PIE when recovering his footing, tracked inside just off the pace, came under encouragement at the five-sixteenths shifting three wide, was the outermost of three battling briefly in upper stretch for command to the eighth pole, offered up a mild kick in the drive for the place honors unable to match the aforementioned rival in the final furlong. HULETT on the pace inside racing in hand and lightly prompted, got let out at the quarter pole under challenge from both sides, yielded command between those foes at the three-sixteenths, kept on to the eighth pole before weakening in the late stages. KENTUCKY PIE bumped at the start when CHAPMAN recovered his footing, settled four wide towards the rear, came under urging three furlongs out, kept on mildly continuing four wide into upper stretch and weakened in the drive. CASHLEIGH two to three wide towards the rear, came under encouragement angling four to five wide midway on the turn, offered no serious response and weakened. RUN RUN FORREST urged along lightly in pursuit three wide from close range, faded from prominence nearing the half mile pole, continued to lose position through the turn and tired. BROTHER BOB prompted the pace from just off the inside, came under a ride at the three-eighths pole, retreated in the latter portion of the turn and tired.
