IANNONE showed speed along the inside while in hand, soon opened a clear lead, set the pace, drew away in the stretch and reported home a measured winner, ridden out. FALCON'S EYE raced close up early, came wide for the drive and finished gamely outside. CONCORDE LADY chased the pace from the outside and tired in the stretch. DUTCHESS OF WIN chased the pace and tired after a half mile. WILD CRUSADE had no rally. GLITTERING SNOW had no response when roused. LAITEE LEGS had no rally. THERES TROUBLE was outrun. VINO ROUGE tired. NEWSY was outrun. ALY SABIN tired after a half mile. Following a stewards' inquiry, FRENCH FACTOR was determined to be in the hands of the assistant starter and without a rider as the gates opened and was declared a non-starter.
