ROYAL CURRIER prompted the pacesetter from the outside, closed in to increase the pressure coming to the quarter pole, turned for home and was let loose, overhauled SIX FLINGS during the ensuing furlong to take over, appeared vulnerable in the late stages with a pair closing in, but was kept going well enough and long enough to prevail. JET SET VINNY between rivals for most of the way around the turn, was already under encouragement taking the two path into the stretch, got placed outward slightly wider soon afterwards, came home with good late energy, but missed. STARFORADAY slow to settle, picked up interest nearing the end of the backstretch, advanced into contention with a three wide run on the turn, entered the stretch and got heavily roused, made up ground steadily on top one despite drifting out several paths. SAINT DAIMON urged cutting the corner into the lane, had no gain. SIX FLINGS came inward at the break, but was pulled off the nearest opponent before contact could be made, kicked clear of the field well before reaching the half mile pole, was gradually eased over towards the inside, settling along the rail in time for the run around the bend, felt intensified pressure shortly before reaching the quarter pole and was soon asked for a response, gave in to it by upper stretch and steadily tired.
