SING DIXIE SING broke well, set the pace while well rated along the inside, was let out at the three-sixteenths, drew clear through the final furlong under a busy hand ride to the wire. BAILZEE unhurried in the early stages, was placed in the two path through the turn bidding time and saving ground, came under coaxing at the three-eighths, readily gained ground, shifted out four wide at the head of the lane rallying with good energy to garner the place while never a threat to the top. JACKIE MO saved ground through the turn until the head of the stretch, shifted out three wide at the quarter pole, commenced a rally at the three-sixteenths, kicked on willingly, getting outfinished for place honors in the late stages. MON ROSE reserved off the pace saving ground throughout, offered up a mild bid along the inside for the last major share. FORTHELOVEOF ANNA broke well and set up tracking in the two path in close pursuit, came under encouragement to keep pace midway on the turn, remained prominent until the final eighth and steadily weakened thereafter. SASTA GO LUCKY chased the pace three wide and in contention early on, came under a prolonged drive from the three-eighths and steadily retreated.
