ALPHA J assumed a forward position after the start., stalked the pacesetter from off the inside, ranged up upon entering the turn and drew alongside MISS MASTERY as the second fraction was being recorded, had that opponent get set down to a hard drive, yet took over the lead nonetheless before arriving at the end of the turn, got asked for response, still engaged in a fight with the former leader, edged away despite drifting outward from upper to midstretch, staved off the late challenge coming from the runner up to hold sway. CONCEALED sat reserved along the outside for the opening half, turned for home and was put to encouragement, made minimal progress during the initial portion of the stretch drive, altered course outward and came home with belated energy to take the place honors away from MISS MASTERY. MISS MASTERY showed the way from the inside, loosely-pressed down the backstretch, had the pressure intensify after entering the turn, was challenged by the top one after more than halfway around the bend, got put to a hard drive, yielded to an unasked foe, stayed close to the winner thereafter, while getting outfinished second. LOUDER THAN SOUND raced along the outside and mustered up a mild stretch response to grab the last major check. TYPHOON TERI rode the rail for a half, was given her cue and got angled outward from the five-sixteenths pole until three wide by upper stretch, flattened out in the final furlong. CURLIN N TWIRLIN three wide and roused at the three-eighths pole, weakened. MY UPTOWN GAL was grabbed hold after ducking out at the start, was guided over to the rail at the top of the turn, failed to reach a contending position. RICE AND BEANS rushed up between rivals after getting away a beat slow, fell back despite getting asked for a response past the half mile pole.
