Footnotes

J W BLUE three wide through the first turn, settled just off the pace just off the inside, came under encouragement at the five-sixteenths, swung three wide in upper stretch, rallied to collar the front a furlong out, edged clear under a drive to prevail. MASON'S COMPRISE attended the pace from just off the inside, came under light urging at the seven-sixteenths to get the early jump on the leader, took command three furlongs out, inched away in the latter part of the turn getting set down in earnest at the quarter pole, dug in under off sided stick work, got overhauled on the front a furlong from home, kept on mildly to the wire and just held on for the place. KINGS VILLAGE bumped at the start when BULLDOG ON A BONE broke outwards, saved ground in mid pack, remained patiently handled to the quarter pole when set down just off the inside, offered up a mild kick to close in late and just missed the place honors while never threatening the winner. GREELEY'S LAW on the pace in hand along the inside and attended, came under urging at the three-eighths under pressure for the initial time getting displaced at that station, offered up mild kick to stay within aim to the final furlong before weakening in the late stages. RED LEADER three to four wide towards the rear, came under encouragement continuing three wide in upper stretch and offered no serious response. MACHO MUCHACHO two to three wide towards the rear, came under a long drive detached from the main body of the field at the seven-sixteenths, cut the corner into the lane and made no impact. BULLDOG ON A BONE broke out at the start bumping KINGS VILLAGE lightly, tracked inside early on from close range, shifted out to the three path at the six and a half, came under a prolonged drive at the seven-sixteenths, retreated in the latter portion of the turn, then was eased at the head of the stretch.
