SEE THE MUSIC away well from the gate, established the pace along the inside in hand, came under challenge at the quarter pole and was roused spinning just off the inside for home, edged clear under a drive to the eighth pole repulsing the threat, got geared down in the late stages unaware of the oncoming threat under confident handling and just held on from the flying finish of ARC DE NUA. ARC DE NUA jostled between foes at the start due to pressure initiated by SEND THE LIMO who came in at the start, settled just off the inside towards the rear, came under urging three furlongs out, spun three wide for home, gobbled up ground late escaping the view of the geared down leader, finished well and just missed on the wire. SEND THE LIMO lost her footing at the start and came under off sided encouragement coming in to bump RANGER'S GIRL solidly into ARC DE NUA and in turn DI LISSA, tracked the pace inside in range, came under urging at the five-sixteenths to prove the main threat at the quarter pole, swung three wide at that station, was repulsed by the eventual winner a furlong out, chased that foe home with a mild kick to earn the show. DI LISSA bumped at the start in a chain reaction initiated by the aforementioned rival, saved ground just off the pace, came under encouragement three furlongs out, angled three wide for home and weakened in the late stages. PAID EXPECTATIONS two to three wide in range in pursuit early on, came under urging midway on the turn, faded through the latter portion of the turn, swung four wide into upper stretch and weakened. RANGER'S GIRL bumped solidly by SEND THE LIMO at the start and bobbed squeezed between foes, saved ground throughout towards the rear and made no impact. MISS GLORY hustled from the start, got coaxed along three to four wide from mid pack, began to fade nearing the quarter pole, swung five to six wide at that station and tired in the drive.
