SHE'S GOT THE BEAT contested the pace along the inside, drew clear in the stretch and dug in gamely on the rail, just missing. MARTHA'S MUSIC contested the pace while between rivals and tired in the final furlong. CAT ROCKET contested the pace while three wide and tired in the stretch. MARNIE'S WISH raced close up outside, put in a four wide run on the turn and tired in the stretch. PORTOBELLO BELLE stumbled at the start, raced inside and tired.
