WITH ABILITY sprinted clear into the first turn, set the pace along the inside while in hand, drew away when roused in upper stretch and remained well clear while being kept to a drive to the finish. IRVING'S BABY was unhurried early while racing between rivals and stayed on determinedly to earn the place award. DIVERSA showed speed while in hand between rivals, put in a four wide run on the second turn and faded in the final furlong. TRANSCENDENTAL was outrun early, raced five wide on the second turn and had no rally. POCUS HOCUS raced close up inside, saved ground and had no response when roused. UNRESTRAINED was unhurried early on, put in a five wide run on the second turn and tired in the stretch. ZONK chased the pace while three wide and tired in the stretch.
