AFLEET'S ACCLAIM perched three wide off the early pace dispute, moved to take on TRIPENDICULAR once PROUD WILDCAT starting weakening from his earlier efforts, dueled with the former from midway on the turn until the quarter pole, appeared to have been successfully shaken off with an eighth to go, staged a fine comeback to wrest away the lead in the late stages to prove best. TRIPENDICULAR got hooked in a head to head battle with PROUD WILDCAT almost from the get-go while racing along the outside, had just gotten the best of that rival when the top one drew abreast to initiate another duel, raced as a team with the eventual winner from the three-eighths pole to the furlong marker, seemed to have emerged the victor of this tussle but didn't, had the top one cut steadily into the advantage, eventually gaining the lead to prove best. TRICKEY GUY settled into midpack early down the backstretch, was taken in hand off heels as JADE GLORY AGAIN vacated the rail, this occurring in the vicinity of the seven-sixteenths pole, got back going in short order and was placed in the three path at the five-sixteenths pole in preparation for the stretch drive, came home with strong, but belated energy to secure the show. JADE GLORY AGAIN along the inside, was steadied slightly midway down the backstretch as PROUD WILDCAT was tucking along the rail, falling back slightly with the temporary loss of momentum, was taken off the rail shortly after entering the stretch, crossing over in front of TRICKEY GUY and forcing the rival of that mount to steady slightly, turned for home cutting the corner, got out finished. WICKED IRISH inward a bit at the start, was grabbed hold, saved ground and out kicked a pair of weak and tired rivals displaying a mild stretch response. BUSTARELLA came four wide into the lane, lacked the needed response. PROUD WILDCAT went at it head to head with the runner up nearly from the get-go, tucked along the rail shortly after the start, fell back steadily from the midway point on the turn despite having been put to encouragement. Following a Stewards' Inquiry focusing on the winner in the vicinity of the half mile pole as well as a claim of foul lodged by the rider of TRICKEY GUY against the rider of the AFLEET'S ACCLAIM alleging interference at the same location, the result was allowed to stand and declared official.
