Footnotes

REACHING OUT needed only the lightest of hand encouragement to establish control by midpoint down the chute, was gradually taken over to the inside, cut the pace being rated and with the runner up in close pursuit just off his hind quarters, saw that rival range up during the run around the far turn until fully abreast a short distance from the quarter pole, had the rider be the first to commit to a drive, doing so prior to reaching the top of the lane, came out slightly after some intermittent left handed stick work, at most leaning on his nemesis before being pulled off, reached the eighth pole clinging to the barest of leads, bumped lightly several times with BIGGER IS BETTOR as the pair made their way through the next sixteenth, with both parties bearing some responsibility for the contact, edged away late. BIGGER IS BETTOR patiently stalked the winner from the outside for well over a half, closed in readily and arrived at the quarter pole fully latched on, spun into the stretch and was called upon, battled hard but failed to claim the advantage during the ensuing furlong, exchanged a series of light bumps with the top one from midstretch to the sixteenth pole, dug in with good determination the rest of the way to the wire but had to settle for the place. WARRIOR UP three wide departing the backstretch, worked out a tuck closer to the rail a furlong down the road, proved no match. PRECIOUS METAL off the inside, was through after completing three-quarters. COALITION faded off a ground-saving journey.
