**Footnotes**

SHY HUMOR sneaked into the pocket coming to the end of the backstretch, took the inside route for nearly all the way to the quarter pole, was angled three wide into the stretch, got into stride and outfinished KING KEENE to prove best. KING KEENE vied for command from the outside, got overtaken by the winner past the eighth pole, held on well for the place. DUPAY brushed the left side of the starting gate, sat in midpack, was placed three wide at the head of the stretch, flattened out in the final furlong. COMMANDING OFFICER stumbled after bumping with G W'S HAMMER at the start, resulting in the pilot coming out of the irons, sat at or near the back of the field, picked up the pace coming to the top of the lane and came home with good belated energy en route for the last major check. THE KENOSHA KID sat forwardly placed from off the inside until midstretch before backing away. BERNARDO raced three wide for most of the way around the turn, had the rider take hold after coming up on rivals in midstretch, got back going soon afterwards and mustered up a mild kick to mainly improve position. G W'S HAMMER was bumped at the start, saved ground, was put to urging and angled outward in the vicinity of the five-sixteenths marker, had no rally. PURPLE PICO off the inside, lacked the needed response. RIDE'EM COWBOY fanned six wide into the lane to no avail. STORMY FREUD vied from the inside and retreated.
