**Footnotes**

LA VERDAD lightly hand urged after the start, was conceded the advantage by RISKY RACHEL, took up residence in the two path, set the splits, being rated and without facing any resistance, began to edge away coming to the quarter pole, got asked for some run during the opening phases of the drive home, gave it, drifted out slightly in the final sixteenth yet remained comfortably in the clear. HOT RENDEZVOUS got away last after breaking in the air, re-made contact with the ground and got rushed up by the pilot, raced at or near the inside to around the five-sixteenths pole, began to angle outward under strong handling, paused in hand for a stride or two approaching the end of the bend before once again getting put to a drive, raced mostly three wide travelling through the furlong grounds, found clear sailing along rail corridor with an eighth to go, cleared the last obstacle, that being RISKY RACHEL and was sent over to the inside route, finished with good courage to claim the place. SUNNY DESERT three wide leaving the backstretch, got placed in the four path in preparation for stretch run, held on willingly to earn the show. MAKE THE MOMENT quickly tucked along the rail and rode it for nearly a half, swung outward until three to four wide by the end of the furlong grounds, lacked the needed closing punch. HERE'S ZEALICIOUS loosely drafted behind the winner for a half before giving way. CAPE COD CAROL tipped into the three path leaving the midway point on the turn, had no rally. AVE'S HALO stumbled at the start, raced along the outside, commenced the stretch from the six path, came up empty. RISKY RACHEL was eased back a furlong into the event, tracked the winner while saving ground, faltered.
