Footnotes

RUNNING IN CIRCLES broke running and wasted no time establishing control, was well out in the track during the initial stages, angled inward in haste towards the rail after departing the chute, cut the pace, under a good hold, and facing only token pressure from the nearest pursuer, had the rider sneak a peek over his right shoulder before being let out entering the stretch, lengthened away during the ensuing furlong, then went on to increase the winning margin, placed to a hand drive to the end. NOW NOW GIRL chased the winner from the two path and proved no match. LOVE SHACK (IRE) three wide most of the way down the backstretch, was guided a bit closer to the inside early on the turn, rallied mildly after turning for home to take the show. SOUTHERN SUNSTATION three wide, was put to a prolonged drive and tired. DEAN AVENUE bobbled at the start, was coaxed along tracking the front runners from the inside, was eased off the rail in the vicinity of the five-sixteenths pole in preparation for the stretch drive, failed to fire appreciably once fully roused. WESTERN THRILLER saved ground and failed to menace. BEAUTIFUL PICO displayed brief foot.
