### Footnotes

WE NEED V L T'S sat within striking distance off the inside for nearly a half, was already asked for a response, spinning three wide into upper stretch, made little progress during the initial portion of the stretch run, continued onward, crept up steadily on the front runners thereafter. drew alongside just past the sixteenth pole, took over in the final seventy yards and held sway. MISSISSIPPI TOO rated stalking the pacesetter from the two path, was put to a hard drive from the quarter pole, caught up to the former pacesetter leaving the furlong grounds, battled for the lead, but got out finished. MY SIRE'S FIRE away alertly, was placed under a snug hold, but opened up a loose lead nonetheless, sailed along the rail during the run around the turn, still under a firm hold and still untested, felt some pressure for the first time nearing the eighth pole, held her ground well, before weakening in the late stages. FIVEFIFTEEN was taken in hand after lunging at the break, raced along the outside, was asked to pick up the pace coming to the five-sixteenths pole, swung wide into lane, winding up in the five path at the head of the stretch, got called upon and came home with good, but belated energy. SEZZANA was guided to the rail at the seven-sixteenths pole and faltered. KARAKORUM FUGITIVE raced along the inside, pulled on the bit briefly, appearing somewhat unsettled coming to the half mile pole, rated more kindly soon afterwards, eased off the inside in time for the stretch run, spun from the four path into the stretch but lacked the necessary response.
