Footnotes

AMBASSADOR BRIDGE bided time three wide until the five-sixteenths pole, was given his cue and angled sharply four wide into the stretch, got straightened away with no loss of momentum and rapidly cut into the leader's margin, went by a short distance from the eighth pole and kicked away. TACTICAL SAENZ commenced the pursuit of the front runners at the top of turn four wide, closed the gap to reach a good striking position nearing the quarter pole, now only being three wide, was a few strides into the stretch before getting asked for his best, couldn't keep pace with the winner in the late stages but continued onward in a willing manner to secure second. TYCOON CAT ducked over to the rail coming to the top of the lane, stayed there for a good portion of the way down the lane before getting taken outward once more, mustered up a mild response for the show. WINNING PAL was bumped soundly from between rivals at the start, raced from off the inside, swung four wide into the stretch, lacked a solid closing response. LUXURY APPEAL rushed up after being bumped at the start, vied for the lead from the inside, came under heavy pressure approaching the quarter pole, succumbed to it soon afterwards and steadily weakened. TROUBLEINRIVITYCITY worked out a tuck into the two path coming to the end of the backstretch, chased the front runners from midpack, had no rally. DREAM OF SCIPPIO underwent a three wide pursuit for most of the way on the turn and tired. JACKIN MY STYLE raced along the outside and was outrun. THAT'S GIN broke outward resulting in making solid contact with the nearest opponent, raced towards the inside and was no menace. GRAND AWARD pressed the issue from the two path for a little over a half before giving way.
