CHRISTIESBORNTORUN got off a sluggish start, picked up the pace upon entering the turn, taking the two path for most of the way around it, was driven six wide into the stretch, got straightened away and began to rally in earnest, left the eighth pole having settled into his best stride, zipped by the runner up late. NIGHT MANEUVER assumed a forward position soon after the start, was patiently handled keeping a watchful eye on the front runners until halfway around the turn, ranged up to confront them with a sixteenth to go before arriving at the quarter pole, was the outermost of a tightly bunched threesome heading for the stretch, bumped several times with READYTODEFER in upper stretch, showed no ill effects from the contact and kicked away to a comfortable advantage, got caught late and had to settle for the place. DR DISCO underwent a four wide pursuit and held on well for the show, although never posing a serious threat to either of the first two finishers. VEXOR argued to maintain control initially one on one with READYTODEFER, had NIGHT MANEUVER make it a three way tussle late on the turn, spun into the lane still on even terms with each of the two previously mentioned rivals, bumped with the former in upper stretch, stayed on prominently placed for a little while longer before tiring. READYTODEFER disputed the pace from the two path, had the runner up join the fight in the vicinity of the five-sixteenths marker, turned for home wedged between opponents, was bumped from between several times in upper stretch, getting slightly squeezed back nearing the eighth pole, tried to get going again but quickly flattened out. HACKLETON raced along the outside, commenced the stretch run five wide, had no response. SOVEREIGN DEFAULT sat a loose pocket for nearly a half, was put to strong encouragement and swung to the outside past the five-sixteenths pole, tired. SENSATIONAL SLAM quickly tucked along the rail and was outrun. WAR COLONY three wide departing the backstretch, trailed.
