Footnotes

MADRE DITUTTICAPI took up the chase from the two path during much of the opening half, tucked along the inside route midpoint on the turn, was given his cue and cut the corner into the lane appearing to be full of run, altered course outward midway through the furlong grounds, settled into his best stride, collared the runner up with about a sixteenth remaining and edged away, briskly hand urged while crossing the finish line. THE ROYAL BOOT quickly cleared the field and was sent over to the rail, remained along it while proceeding around the bend, got set down for the drive home, held her ground well during the ensuing furlong, had the winner snatch away the advantage in the vicinity of the sixteenth pole, remained safely in front for place honors. OFF MY CLOUD saved ground early, tipped outward gradually leaving the five-sixteenths marker, settling into four path by the end of the maneuver while occurred in midstretch, rallied belatedly for the show. MATCHING SKIES three wide departing the backstretch, swung five wide into the stretch, got straightened away and lacked the needed response. HEIR TO DARE chased from the two path, gave way.
