ATELIER showed good speed while well in hand, advanced outside on the second turn, dug in resolutely in the stretch and prevailed after a long drive. POMPEII was rated along early, rallied three wide approaching the stretch, finished gamely from the outside and just missed after drifting out through the final sixteenth. TAX AFFAIR quickly opened a clear lead, set the pace while well in hand, dug in when joined by the winner nearing the stretch and fought it out gamely to the finish. PENTATONIC was outrun early, raced inside and had no rally.
