APPIAN WAY was coaxed from the three path in pursuit of the pacesetter, got put to encouragement spinning into the lane, closed the gap during the ensuing furlong, continued onward, took over a few strides before the sixteenth pole and drew well clear. ALARMIST showed the way, rated in the two path and with the top one in close attendance directly to the outside, continued along on the same scenario until upper stretch, got let out as APPIAN WAY issued a challenge in earnest at that juncture, surrendered the front with about a sixteenth remaining, continued on to be easily second best. OMMADON'S REIGN took up the chase from the outside, drifted out to be five wide at the three-sixteenths pole after being on receiving end of left handed stick work, proved no match for the top twosome. PEGASUS HELLAS raced from off the rail and folded. CALL UP THE CHIEF saved ground to no avail. S. Z. MADISON three wide departing the backstretch, tired. CRESCENT MOON DR off the inside, was outrun. SANDICAN took bad steps coming to the quarter pole, was quickly pulled up and vanned off.
