SPECIAL ACTION tracked the front initially from midpack in behind the leaders, nudged his way out to the three path midway down the backside, took command by a slim margin entering the far turn, extended his advantage swinging three wide into the lane and edged clear, saw that margin dwindle down in the last sixteenth to just prevail being kept to task to the end. OUT OF YOUR MIND reserved in midpack, saved ground throughout, was set down at the three sixteenths after spinning for home and waiting briefly for a lane to open up, rallied with good energy through the stretch and just missed. L L FLYING NOTES broke in at the start bumping with CREA'S LAW resulting in JACKIN MY STYLE getting squeezed back, settled just off the pace in the two path, came under a spirited ride at the top of the stretch while three wide, offered up a mild kick for show honors. JACKIN MY STYLE squeezed back at the start and taken in hand when CREA'S LAW was forced into his lane by the errant LL FLYING NOTES, was unhurried early on towards the rear, swung five wide at the top of the lane and offered up a mild bid for the last major share. L. C. SLEEPY settled towards the rear in the two path, came under a long drive from the three eighths pole, made headway on the front, shifted to the rail nearing the final furlong and was out kicked late. EL CORRIENTE threw his head at the start and was off a beat slow as a result, raced towards the rear, swung six wide in upper stretch and rallied by tired foes in the lane. PAVLOV'S DOG keen early on resisting the hold by the rider, vied for command in the two path until the head of the lane and faded. CREA'S LAW bumped at the start by his outside rival who broke inward, chased the pace initially three wide down the backside while prominently placed, was nudged out one path by the eventual winner midway down the backside, remained in contention until upper stretch and faltered. SORRY NO REFUNDS vied inside for a half and gave way.
