### Footnotes

RODINIA away without apparent mishap, took control by the end of the chute, was rated two to three wide while setting the pace, kicked away to a comfortable advantage proceeding around the bend, got asked for some run after completing three-quarters, was still comfortably in front with a furlong remaining, had the rider first take a peek back from the right, then from the left, saw the only possible danger rallying along the inside route, had sufficient clearance and was guided over to the rail, leading the runner up to alter course belatedly, held on safely. MAXANA was stationed along the inside route, picked up interest when asked to past the midway point on the turn, cut the corner menacingly, full of run and momentum, continued to chop away at the leader's advantage during the ensuing furlong, did so more readily so as to make things interesting with less than a sixteenth to go, had the winner get race ridden over into his path in deep stretch, altered course in the late stages and fell short. GREAT GRACIE DANE chased the top one three to four wide, was put to a prolonged drive, tired. KATE IS A TEN raced along the outside, commenced the stretch three wide, had no offering. SUGAR BEACH saved ground to the five-sixteenths marker and gave way.
