KNOCK AGAIN set the pace along the inside, drew clear in the stretch and was driving for the score. SILENT WEST raced greenly early on, came wide nearing the stretch and finished well outside. RED ACE raced outside on the turn, inside in the stretch and had no rally. SERAZZO raced with the pace while three wide and tired in the final furlong. DIVERSIFICATION raced with the pace while between rivals and tired in the stretch. TIGER RIDGE raced inside and had no response when roused. PROVOST MARSHALL chased inside and tired.
