TRANSCENDENTAL was hustled from the gate, contested the pace while between rivals and stayed on gamely through the stretch. FOR GRANTED contested the pace along the inside and stayed on well through the stretch. SAND DOLLAR raced with the pace from the outside, dropped back on the turn and came again along the inside in the stretch. CLASSY SOLUTION contested the pace while four wide and tired in the stretch. PADDOCK PASS contested the pace while three wide and tired. MANOR SPRINGS broke awkwardly, raced greenly and tired.
