**Footnotes**

METEOROLOGIST contested the pace from the outside, drew clear into the stretch then dug in gamely along the inside and held on under a drive. STAR DABBLER raced close up along the inside, came wide into the stretch and finished gamely outside. THAT'S A GIVEN showed speed from the outside, put in a four wide run on the turn and tired in the final furlong. MASS CHARLES was bumped after the start, put in a four wide run on the turn and had nothing left for the stretch drive. PURELY PLATINUM was bumped after the start, causing his rider to loose an iron, then raced wide throughout and finished well outside. DON'T PARK NOW stumbled at the start, was bumped, was taken up, dropped far back early, raced inside and was going well too late. DISCREET THIEVERY was bumped after the start, chased the pace while three wide and tired in the stretch. TRIPPED UP was outrun early and lacked a rally. SAVIANO contested the pace along the inside and tired in the stretch. OLD TIME TALE was bumped at the start and had no response when roused. UNCLE FESTOR showed speed along the inside and tired after a half mile. TIZMENOW was bumped after the start, raced wide and tired.
