SCHOOLYARD CAT slowly advanced into contention after departing the backstretch, angled three wide for the stretch drive, was herded towards the rail by the runner up in upper stretch, battled onward for the lead, traded a series of bumps with FUGEDABOUTIT SANDY commencing from the eighth pole, with both parties seemingly to bear some responsibility for each incident, a total of four in all, raced courageously despite all the contact and gamely got the nod. FUGEDABOUTIT SANDY pressed the pacesetter three wide, moved up under some encouragement to engage that rival leaving the five-sixteenths pole, turned for home on nearly even terms when bumped into by that one, causing him to bobble the next stride after the contact, forged on ahead for the lead, came inward a couple paths soon afterwards, in response to right handed encouragement but by now holding the lead, carrying inward the eventual winner in the process, went on to bump with that foe several times during the ensuing furlong, bobbling and losing stride at least twice, battled gamely to end but had to settle for the place. SOUTHBEACHSANDY began the run around the bend four wide but ended it closer to the inside, finished willingly down the stretch to earn the show. GOOD TO BE ME four wide for most of the way on the turn, gathered up momentum under some urging coming to the five-sixteenths pole, flattened out leaving the furlong grounds. DAKOTA ROADHOUSE slammed hard into the right side of the gate, raced five wide and failed to reach a contending position. SARATOGA SQUIER raced near the inside and tired. SEWAN INDIAN set the pace slightly off the rail, came out a bit after only one left handed shot entering the stretch, bumped with the runner up and gave way soon afterwards. BACKSTAGE JOHNNIE a forward factor early, dropped back quickly nearing the end of the backstretch and was eased approaching the quarter pole.
