Footnotes

GOLDEN MAN was well placed in the early stages, swung four wide while gaining at the quarter pole, opened a clear advantage in upper stretch, dug in when challenged in deep stretch and was all out to hold on in the final strides. MUCHO GUSTO was outrun early after breaking slowly, saved ground to the turn, swung six wide in upper stretch and finished strongly in the middle of the track but could not get up. HANDSOME REWARD raced in traffic at the half mile pole, moved around the leader while gaining on the turn, dropped back to the rail in upper stretch and rallied belatedly. PEPERONI was reserved for a half, swung four wide at the quarter pole and rallied mildly. INTIYACO (ARG) rushed up inside, took up sharply inside the pacesetter nearing the quarter pole, steadied again while lacking room on the rail in upper stretch and failed to threaten thereafter. ANOTHER FOOSE steadied between horses at the half mile pole, made a move from outside to challenge leaving the turn and gave way thereafter. EXCEL failed to mount a serious rally while four wide. FLY PASS set the pace along the rail for a half and faltered.
