EVEN FRISKY unhurried for the initial half, was asked for some run departing the backstretch, came under still strong handling approaching the five-sixteenths pole, raced in tandem, with the runner up directly to the outside, overhauling TALK TO NICK just past the three-sixteenths pole, went head to head with TAPPED OUT BRUNO to the finish line and proved best. TAPPED OUT BRUNO patiently took the inside route, eased into the two path at the five-sixteenths pole, spun three wide into the stretch under urging, went by the former pacesetter, along with the top one, in upper stretch, battled hard the rest of the way for the lead, but got out gamed. ADMIRALTY tracked the pacesetter under a firm hold while saving ground, angled outward for the stretch run, got called upon but proved no match for the top twosome. SARATOGA COWBOY four wide at the half mile pole, folded. TALK TO NICK well rated along the rail laying down moderate splits, yielded readily in upper stretch and steadily tired thereafter. NEXT DAY raced along the outside, was roused midway on the turn, but failed to muster up any closing punch.
