DR. TOM was coaxed prompting the pacesetter from the two path, advanced to issue a challenge for the lead coming to the quarter pole, turned for home with FOOTMARK on nearly even terms, needed only a few more strides to take over, emerged from the furlong grounds with a clear advantage and was kept busy to the end to maintain it. KARAKORUM BUDMAN chased three wide and came home willingly to take the place. LOYAL LEADER was taken off a rival after coming inward slightly leaving the starting gate, raced along the outside, commenced to rally from the three path at the head of the stretch and displayed a mild kick en route for the show. BROOKLYN BOUND four wide at the three-eighths pole, improved position once straightened away in upper stretch. FOOTMARK off sharply, quickly grabbed the lead, was released from an early firm hold when the top one ranged up early to apply some pressure, showed the way from the inside, still not having been asked for his best, was put to the test approaching the quarter pole, succumbed readily and tired. RIGHTUPLYNN'SALLEY asked from the get-go, was always inside and tired. MILLENNIUMSUNRISE saved ground until the quarter pole and was outrun.
