Footnotes

MIAMI HAMMER stacked five wide departing the backstretch, remained the widest off all during the run around the bend, was let out approaching the head of the stretch, took over soon afterwards and had no difficulty fending off the lone stretch threat. HOKUSAI unhurried down the backstretch, took over the three path from a weakening rival midpoint on the turn, gradually advanced forward, with the rider holding something in reserve, turned for home four wide, got asked for a response, attempted to cut into the top one's advantage, wasn't up to the task, but proved to be second best. TONY'S BACK vied briefly between rivals, entered the turn, from the two path, and the innermost of a three-way pace dispute around the bend, began to lose contact after entering the stretch and steadily weakened thereafter. KNOWN GAMBLER fought for the lead along the inside for a half, and gave way. VIRTUES UNDER FIRE four wide at the half mile pole, was through after completing three-quarters. LOGICAL ORDER forwardly placed three wide for five furlongs, faltered.
