Footnotes

J TO THE CROFT tucked along the inside, argued for command, being rated for the opening half, entered the stretch and was soon called upon, shook free of VONA during the run through the furlong grounds, came out several paths after some strong left handed stick work with seventy yards remaining, held on safely. COST AFFECTIVE was patiently handled keeping an eye on the front runners while acing around the bend, remained under a good hold by the pilot lacking suitable options from the five-sixteenths marker to the quarter pole, was given his cue and got sharply four wide into the stretch, took off in earnest after finishing the maneuver and gained ground readily, continued to whittle away at the advantage but fell short. VONA three wide, pressed the issue as the widest of a threesome for a half, stayed a prominent factor for an additional furlong before backing away. CASHMERE CAT broke inward, leaning on CONSTANTINE for the next few jumps, contended for the lead racing between opponents for much of the initial half, gave way. SENDARIO got off a beat slowly, raced at or near the inside proceeding down the backstretch, ducked out towards the four path coming to the midway point on the turn, continued from off the rail thereafter, was already under a full drive taking the three path for entrance into the stretch, made no impact. CONSTANTINE was pushed in slightly by CASHMERE CAT at the start, raced in the two path on the bend, put to a drive past the three-eighths pole, tired.
