Footnotes

MATT AND JESSE towards the inside early, wandered into the two path midway down the backstretch, took the same one around the bend, having been put to a drive a few strides past the half mile pole, picked up interest noticeably prior to turning for home, was four wide for the commencement of the stretch, closed in willingly on the front runners from upper to mid lane, continued onward, went by them in the vicinity of the sixteenths pole and kicked away. ROAD AGENT vied for command while racing along the inside, lightly handed urged while doing, continued along on the same scenario for nearly three-quarters, got let out for the drive home, fought ferociously with RESERVED QUALITY with only heads separating the twosome, had just came out slightly when over hauled by the winner with a sixteenth to go, gamely won the place. RESERVED QUALITY chased the front runners while taking the two path, tipped outward at the five-sixteenths pole and entered the stretch three wide, reached even terms with the runner up shortly afterwards, appeared to be the first to reach the furlong marker, albeit by the barest of margins, shied out for a couple of jumps near the sixteenth pole, reacting to momentary waywardness by ROAD AGENT, fought to go past that one again but was staved off. CHILTON contended for control from the two path, initially put to a firm hold by the pilot, was under much stronger handling coming to the head of the stretch, got turned back by the second place finisher and backed away. CAT MAN FU under some urging nearly from the get-go, tracked the front runners while taking the inside route for six furlongs, came three wide into the stretch, tired.
