OLD UPSTART had control established before reaching the end of the chute, sat entrenched in the two path, showing the way, well rated and with PEACEFUL TALK in the general vicinity parked out three wide, had that rival range up coming to the quarter pole and bid in earnest, got set down, rebuffed the challenger, held sway, driving. KILLER CROSSOVER fidgety seconds before the gate was sprung open, lunged up at the start, settled into mid pack making his way down the backstretch, departed the backstretch from the two path and loosely drafted behind the winner until the five-sixteenths pole, angled outward, ending the maneuver being five wide, took off after the front runners, displayed a good kick to garner the place. PEACEFUL TALK stalked the winner from the three path, issued a strong challenge as the pair headed for the top of the lane, got held at bay then steadily weakened. EIGHT CENTS was off sluggishly, travelled two wide around the turn, was already under a drive spinning into the stretch slightly wider, had no gain. JACKSON N LORIMER came in sharply leaving the starting gate, herding both next door neighbors, tucked along the inside, cut the corner into the lane under strong encouragement, came up empty. NEOCLASSIC pushed in slightly at the start, departed the backstretch from the two path, turned for home under a drive, made no headway. DUKATI was forced inward by JACKSON N LORIMER, raced three wide on the bend, stopped after going three-quarters, got eased and put to a protective hold, walked across the finish line for the final slice of the pot.
