RETTALFA saved ground towards the rear after crossing to the inside at the start, began to advance through the latter portion of the turn into prominence nearing the quarter pole, swung three wide into upper stretch set down for the drive, rallied steadily gaining outside a pair to take over in the late stages and inched away to the wire. BLUE BALLERINA coaxed from the inside, cut the pace along the inside, got roused at the head of the stretch, dug in under threat from a pair through the final eighth, got caught in the late stages and held for the place. JEALOUS broke in at the start closing the path of RETTALFA who opted inside, raced two to three wide in pursuit from in range, came under urging at the five-sixteenths cornered just off the inside, rallied between rivals through the final furlong, was in a bit tight between those foes a sixteenth out while out kicked to the wire, well clear of the rest for the show. FLY SOLO tracked the pace inside early in mid pack, came under urging four wide three furlongs from home, angled five wide into upper stretch, offered no response. STRONG ENOUGH three to four wide towards the rear, came under encouragement five wide midway on the turn, swung six wide for home and made no impact. NO IT'S NOT ME showed brief speed chasing just off the inside forwardly placed early on, came under urging midway on the turn, faded through the latter portion of the turn and tired.
