SILENT SERENADE raced close up inside while in hand, angled out and rallied three wide approaching the stretch, dug in gamely when roused and prevailed under a drive. TRUE ROSE was outrun early, came wide into the stretch and finished gamely outside. HOME ON THE HILL showed speed from the outside, was briefly clear nearing the stretch and weakened along the inside in the final furlong. ARPEGGIO was outrun early, came wide for the drive and was going well outside late. MOORESTOWN showed speed along the inside and tired after a half mile.
