Footnotes

TAX MAN stalked three wide, lodged a bid from outside on the turn, opened a wide gap in midstretch and drew off under pressure. INTERFERENCE raced well back along the rail leaving the turn then rallied belatedly. POWERFUL STORM raced in midpack, gained three wide on the turn and improved his position late. DR. POWDERLY set the pace under pressure to the turn and weakened. GAMBLIN FEVER raced just off the pace on the rail leaving the turn and lacked a late response. SMARTY KARAKORUM saved ground on the turn, swung three wide and lacked a rally. YOU BET I'M READY pressed the pace between horses to the turn and gave way. ADAM'S NAY never reached contention. SKILLZ THAT KILL dropped back early and was outrun. Fog covered the course for most of the way.
