Footnotes

PATRIOTIC DUTY settled into midpack after the start, tracked the front runners while saving ground, unasked for run, was given his cue and proceeded to angle into the two path coming to the five-sixteenths marker, had the former leader vacate the inside route himself at the commencement of the stretch, altered course back to the newly-created rail passageway in upper stretch, scurried past the wayward runner up to take over with a furlong to go, edged away. READ THE PROPOSAL was put to a snug left after an apparent uneventful start, got out and continued to do so throughout the running, was along the overland route when taking over from SPIRITED TOUCH, got successfully pounced upon by the eventual winner by the end of the furlong grounds, continued onward in a willing manner to stay well clear of the others for the place. DUCKS DOCK saved ground to the quarter pole, rallied to finish a non-threatening third. CRAQUI had the rider take hold after breaking slightly to the outside, tucked along the inside route past the half mile pole, faltered off the subsequent ground-saving journey. SPIRITED TOUCH broke in front, maintained the advantage and was guide over towards the rail, cut the pace, rated and with the closest pursuer well to the outside, drifted into the two path turning for home, got overhauled, continued to drift out steadily while backing away. PEGASUS RED gave chase from the two path, folded.
