SOVEREIGN DEFAULT vied for the lead from the inside, got let out for the drive home, dug in well to prevail. GRIFFIN ROCK kept watch on the winner while sitting in the pocket, was briefly caught in some traffic as three-quarters was being completed, came into the stretch, managed to alter course to the outside shortly afterwards, finished willingly although no match for the top one. SOUTHBEACHSANDY bumped solidly with MONEY ONLY after stumbling at the start, was yanked away from that opponent, raced primarily three wide on the bend, got called upon for some run leaving the five-sixteenths pole, lacked the needed response. AWAKE AT T WIRE rated in the two path keeping the winner company, tired steadily after completing six furlongs. WASHINGTON'S RULES was placed five wide at the head of the stretch to no avail. MONEY ONLY was bumped at the start, saved ground on the turn, failed to pick up the pace when asked to past the three-eighths pole. JUNIOR OFFICER urged four wide into the stretch, tired.
