Footnotes

MARRIEDTOTHMUSIC initially hand urged, was switched over to being rated after establishing control, cut the pace from the inside, drew away to a comfortable lead heading to the quarter pole, got asked for some run after settling into upper stretch, emerged from the furlong grounds in possession of his biggest advantage, stayed well in the clear. DIGHTON saved ground until more than halfway around the bend, was already under strong encouragement fanning outward into the stretch, wound up in the six path midway through the furlong grounds, finished willingly to be second best. COOLUSIVE rode the rail, got taken outward starting from near the three-sixteenths pole, ended the move being five wide, got up for the show. MR. O'LEARY in slightly, made contact with MR. RIGHT, raced from off the inside, was three wide and asked for a response by the five-sixteenths marker, failed to give it. CHAPMAN was under urging chasing the winner from the two path, got shaken off before the half had been completed. JETER three wide departing the backstretch, gave way. MR. RIGHT took an awkward initial step leaving the starting gate, shied inward getting bumped by MR. O'LEARY almost immediately afterwards, raced between rivals during the run around the bend, taking the two path, entered the stretch, got steadied as COOLUSIVE was being maneuvered to the outside in upper stretch, failed to regain any interest. CAP THE MOMENT away awkwardly, stumbled at the start, appeared choppy-gaited for the majority of the way down the backstretch, was guided over to the rail, picked up some interest coming to the quarter pole, angled out soon afterwards, failed to gain.
