MAGNIFICENT MOON broke on top despite stumbling at the start, was forwardly placed in hand on the pace just off the inside, came under pressure early from ALY'S FAVORITE BOY along the inside, shook away from that foe nearing the half mile pole, widened away through the turn, cornered just off the inside patiently handled for home, got roused nearing the eighth pole and held clear to the wire. MAD PROPS saved ground at the rear early on, came under encouragement three furlongs out advancing through the turn, proved no match for the top one while offering up a mild kick clear of the rest and second best. URAGANO just off the inside in mid pack, advanced along the inside through the turn, cut the corner for home, offered no serious response while along for the show. BUNDLER three wide towards the rear, came under urging three furlongs out, swung four to five wide for home, made no impact. ALY'S FAVORITE BOY a bit fractious in the gate prior to the start, broke half a beat slow, came under hustling to pressure the pace along the inside briefly down the backside, got shaken off by the eventual winner, faded through the turn under a drive from midway and tired. TALON'S PAPA showed brief speed in range from just off the inside, retreated before a half growing detached from the main body of the field and was eased in the stretch.
