PERSONAL ASSISTANT broke formation from a tightly-bunched group in the early stages to take up the role of stalker, gradually closed in on the pacesetter during the run around the bend, took over shortly before reaching the quarter pole, drew off, crossing the wire under brisk hand encouragement. HANDSOME HARBOR along the outside, was put to a long hard drive, proved no match. JET SET CAT in tight between rivals, steadied in the vicinity of the nine-sixteenths pole, was guided over to the rail midway on the turn, went on to best the rest. MISSILEWHILEUWORK made the front under his own power, carved the pace from the rail, got confronted by the winner nearing the quarter pole, readily succumbed and tired. HAPPY HIGH raced three wide and folded. BRASS NOTE took the inside route for the opening half, was asked for run leaving the gate and until the quarter pole, drifted four wide into the stretch, tiring.
