Footnotes

SLIVER OF SILVER settled just off the early pace, launched a rally three wide entering the stretch, surged to the front inside the sixteenth pole then was fully extended to hold on in the closing strides. NOTE TO MIMI raced in the middle of the pack along the backstretch, rallied along the inside to reach contention in upper stretch, altered course to the outside a sixteenth out then closed late but could not get up. TWILIGHTINTHE CITY sprinted clear in the early stages, set the pace under pressure along the inside on the turn, continued on the front into deep stretch and weakened. CHEROKEE RACER raced in the middle of the pack while four wide to the top of the stretch and finished evenly. SALT FLAKE failed to mount a serious rally. HEY HEY SUNNY checked at the start, raced far back for a half, altered course to the outside while finding her best stride in upper stretch then rallied belatedly in the middle of the track. IS A DOLL was never a factor. QUIET CALLER never reached contention. SHE'S SO UNUSUAL pressed the pace from outside into upper stretch and gave way.
