TALE OF EKATI raced close up outside while in hand, advanced outside on the second turn, angled to the inside in upper stretch, dug in gamely on the rail and was up in time. WAR PASS quickly showed in front, set the pace under pressure from INNER LIGHT, put away that rival and drew clear on the second turn, took a clear lead past the eighth pole and dug in gamely but could not hold off the winner. COURT VISION was outrun early, put in a five wide run on the second turn and finished well on the far outside. GIANT MOON raced in hand inside, saved ground, rallied inside on the second turn and stayed on well on the rail. ANAK NAKAL was outrun early, put in a five wide run on the second turn and had little left for the stretch drive. SPURRIER was outrun early, raced inside and had no response when roused. ROMAN EMPEROR was outrun early, was steadied along the inside on the second turn and tired. TEXAS WILDCATTER chased the pace along the inside and tired after three quarters. INNER LIGHT pressed the pace from the outside and was finished after a half mile.
