Footnotes

STAGE DEBUT grabbed a forward position in the initial stages, shook off the early challenge coming from SUAVE SAILOR, entered the turn from the rail and was forced to fend off a pair of rivals, did so successfully, edged away from them to turn for home in possession of a comfortable advantage, got set down, drew off from the field during the stretch drive, despite drifting out noticeably in the final furlong. CAT MAN FU departed the backstretch from the three path under his own power, got called upon for more and more proceeding his way around the bend until put to a full drive by the five-sixteenths pole, was guided closer to the inside in upper stretch until blocked from going any further by ALI'S WINNER, changed course back to the outside for better racing clearance, raced on nearly even terms with the previously mentioned rival during the last eighth and out kicked that opponent for place honors. ALI'S WINNER broke alertly, sat under a firm hold from off the inside to the midway point on the turn, was set down to a hard drive entering the stretch, lost the battle for second. RANGER WES contested the pace from between rivals for much of the way around the bend, got out finished in the late stages and had to settle for the final major check. VICARIOUSLYUTOPIAN took the inside route, was put to a prolonged drive, flattened out. SUAVE SAILOR put up a brief fight for command from the outside before retreating.
