Footnotes

SO SCOTT unhurried during the initial half, picked up interest upon reaching the turn, closed in steadily on the front runners during the run around the bend, was under a drive spinning four wide into upper stretch, got straightened away and continued to gain ground, drew alongside the leader in the vicinity of the sixteenth pole, soon took over and edged away. THIS HARD LAND sat within range from off the inside for nearly three-quarters, turned for home three wide being asked for run, finished willingly to secure second. PANTHRO prompted the pacesetter from the outside, with the rider atop with a firm grip on the reins, made a successful challenge to take over coming to the quarter pole and was soon asked for a response, offered good resistance before yielding with about a sixteenth to go. RUFFINO rated kindly in the opening stages tracking the front runners from the inside, made an abbreviated run at the front runners after entering the stretch, then flattened out. MOONLIGHT SONG broke inward but was pulled off the nearest opponent before significant contact could be made, assumed command from a disinterested group and was tucked along the rail, set the splits, being rated along, was let out some as the pressure intensified late on the turn, succumbed before reaching the quarter pole and faltered. TAP ATTACK outrun for six furlongs, swung four wide into the stretch, had no offering to render.
