VIV'S TIARA broke running and strode under her own power past the field to take control during the straightaway approach leading up to the opening bend, was guided over to rail once sufficiently clear, rated kindly laying down the opening splits, attended in the two path by a well reserved STYLE WATCH, continued along on the same scenario for three-quarters, felt intensified pressure at that juncture as some of the closest pursuers started being asked for run and was let out herself, lengthened away from upper to midstretch, then continued onward with good energy to preserve the margin, crossing the wire under a brisk hand ride. WINERY sat a loose pocket in the early stages, moved up to close the gap on the pacesetter from midway down the backstretch, stayed within striking distance throughout the run around the far turn, waited until the quarter pole before being asked for a response, failed to catch up to the winner, but held quite well nonetheless to secure second. KATY'S OFFICE GIRL brought up the back of the pack for three-quarters, lost some ground taking the six path, under a drive, into upper stretch, came home with good belatedly energy down the center of the course en route for the show. SOME LEGEND darted to the rail after going only a few strides out of the starting gate, was taken hold of down the backstretch, while being rated in midpack, was forced to remain on hold, briefly awaiting options heading for the quarter pole, soon got turned loose, but lacked the needed response. STYLE WATCH patiently prompted the pacesetter from the outside for six furlongs, attempted to bid for command coming to the quarter pole but wasn't up to the task at hand. PROUD SIREN off the inside, was no factor. WORLD PREMIER three wide on the far turn, was under a drive before reaching the five-sixteenths

pole, made no headway on the front runners. BEPPJ three wide around both turns, was through after completing three-quarters. DONNA'S SANDEE between rivals, tired. TWILLERBEE underwent a three to four wide journey and gave way.
