### Footnotes

SOLDIERETTE unhurried early on, gradually made her way outside through the turn to be four wide and clear of traffic, was set down at the head of the lane, was forced to alter course over heels when MY SYDNEY GIRL drifted out badly at the eighth pole, lost very little momentum due to the quick move by the rider and drew clear kept to task. NOLITA chased the pace three wide, came under coaxing midway on the turn, rallied through the lane to just procure the place honors in a three way photo. PURE LOVE between rivals chasing the pace from the two path, came under a long drive from the three-eighths pole, offered up a mild bid for show honors by the slimmest of margins. AUSABLE CHASM chased the pace initially three wide through the turn, was nudged gently out by the eventual winner at the five-sixteenths while under a prolonged drive from the three-eighths, swung five wide into the lane and offered up a mild kick for the last major share. MY SYDNEY GIRL four wide chasing, improved position under her own power through the turn to challenge for command nearing the quarter pole, took over at that station, was let out spinning three wide, drifted in slightly after straightening away, drifted out badly from the eighth pole to the wire despite the rider's attempts to keep a straight course was displaced and tired. LUCK IN THE CITY off a beat slow, was outrun early on, saved ground throughout and was no factor. HOOK IT UP tracked the pace inside, was set down at the quarter pole and faltered. NUMBER ONE CHERRY broke well and set the pace initially off the inside, made her way to the rail near the seven-sixteenths, came under a drive near the five-sixteenths, was displaced at the head of the lane and gave way.
